The committee is responsible for reviewing and evaluating funding requests from nonprofit and cooperative organizations that align with the Bank's mission and values.

Our focus areas include childcare, cooperative development, education, healthcare, affordable and low-income housing, youth programs, civic and cultural initiatives, elderly care, services for individuals experiencing homelessness, self-help programs, and support for people with disabilities.

Through our work, we aim to make a meaningful impact by empowering organizations that address vital social needs and promote economic inclusion and community well-being.

- **Corporate Contributions Committee and Charity Nominations**

NCB has established a Corporate Contributions Committee to review requests and make recommendations for contributions to community-based service organizations within the regional territories in which the Bank conducts business. Any employee of either organization can submit a request for funds for a 501(c) 3 organization that they are (financially or physically) involved in. Requests are reviewed monthly, based on alignment to key focus areas and needs.
